### Our State of Pennsylvania

The United States has 50 states. All of the states have a capital city. We live in Pennsylvania, and the capital is Harrisburg. Pennsylvania is a very big state. It has many people living in it. The population is more than 12,800,000! There are 67 counties, and we live in Chester County. Kennett Square, Avondale, Landenberg, West Grove, and Oxford are all towns in Chester County.

Pennsylvania is close to the states of Delaware, Maryland, and New Jersey. Do you know the capitals of these states? The capital of Delaware is **Dover**. The capital of Maryland is **Annapolis**, and the capital of New Jersey is **Trenton**.

Pennsylvania has many large cities, like Pittsburgh, Allentown, Erie, Bethlehem, and Lancaster. The largest city in Pennsylvania is Philadelphia. It is about 45 minutes from Kennett Square by car, and it has a population of 1,591,800. Philadelphia has an international airport, an aquarium, many museums, and beautiful churches. It has the Liberty Bell and Independence Hall, where the Declaration of Independence was signed in 1776. Philadelphia was the capital of the United States from 1790 to 1800.

Do you live in Kennett Square? It is not a city—it is a town. It is not as big as Philadelphia, but it is not too small. The population of Kennett Square is 6,200. Kennett Square is famous because it is the Mushroom Capital of the World. It is also famous because it has Longwood Gardens. They are beautiful gardens, and they have many incredible plants and flowers to admire.
